

COURT SWORD DUEL

Watch a demonstration of fencing with court swords in this historic court!

The courtyard of the original castle built by Louis XIII, the Marble Courtyard is easily identifiable with its black and white tiles. Many performances were staged in this courtyard, overlooked by the balcony of the king's bedroom.



ROYAL CHAPEL

WELCOME

Paved with marble, this large room with columns opening onto the Royal Chapel is decorated with a high relief representing Louis XIV crossing the Rhine, the work of the Coustou brothers.

CONCERT

Musicians and singers take you back to the 17th century with a baroque sacred music concert!

The Royal Chapel, designed by the architect Jules Hardouin-Mansart, was completed at the end of the reign of Louis XIV. Every morning, the Court attended the King's mass from the royal gallery, surrounded by his family. Recently restored, the Royal Chapel, which witnessed many royal weddings until 1789, once again reveals all its splendor!
